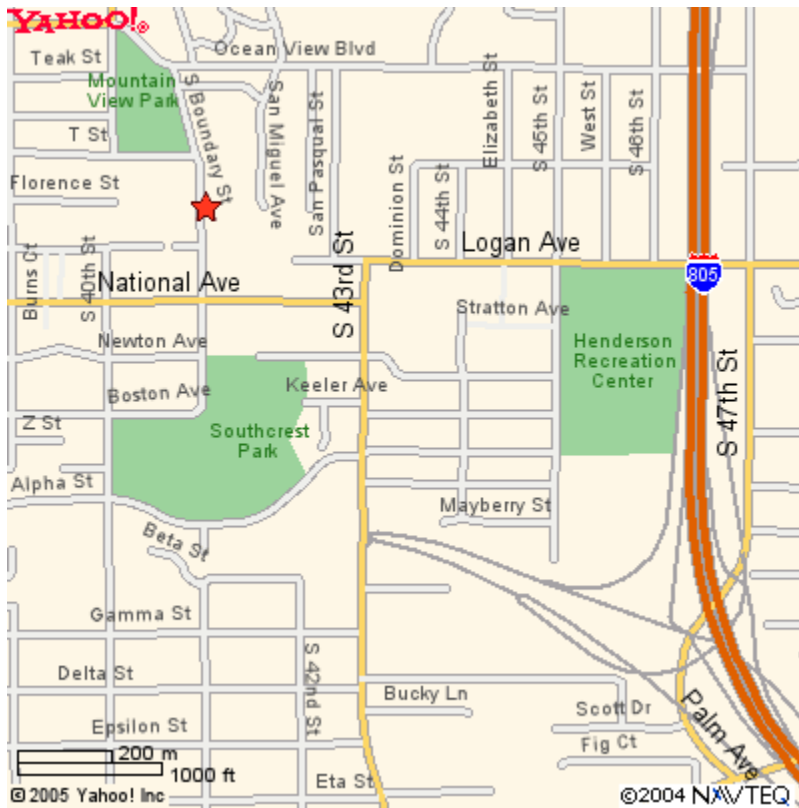
**Directions to Neighborhood House Association – 841 South 41st Street

From I-805 Exit at 43rd Street

Turn RIGHT on 43rd STREET

Go to 2nd SIGNAL LIGHT and turn LEFT on NATIONAL AVENUE

Go to next intersection and turn RIGHT on 41ST STREET
